SUBJECT: Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act (UIGEA) of 2006

Dear Commercial Account Customer:

In accordance with the requirements of the Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 and Regulation GG, we are required to notify all commercial customers that as of June 1, 2010, restricted transactions related to unlawful Internet gambling activities are prohibited from being processed through your account. Restricted transactions are transactions in which a person or corporation accepts credit, funds or other proceeds from another person or corporation in connection with unlawful Internet gambling.

As defined in Regulation GG, unlawful Internet gambling means to “place, receive or otherwise knowingly transmit a bet or wager by any means which involves the use, at least in part, of the Internet where such a bet or wager is unlawful under any applicable Federal or State law in the State or Tribal lands in which the bet or wager is initiated, received or otherwise made.” If the bank determines that you engage in transactions of this nature, we will take steps to block or restrict such activity.

Public Funds and political subdivisions are exempt from this Act and may disregard this letter.
